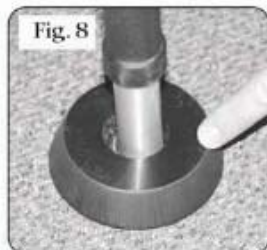
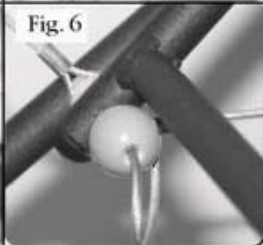
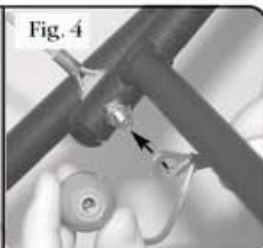
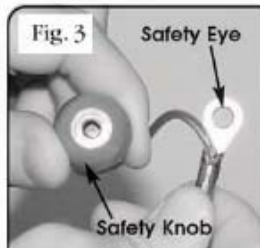
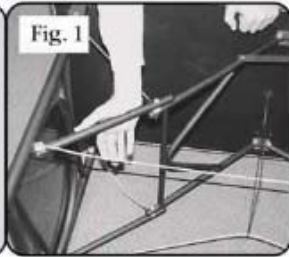


Set-up Instructions for the Portable Taping Table



To Set-up:

- Fig. 1 • Pull out the legs until they are in the position shown and push on the folding braces at the pivot so the cables are taut.
- Fig. 2 • **IMPORTANT:** Extend Safety Locking Cable to opposite leg.
- Fig. 3-6 • **IMPORTANT:** Place the Safety Eye over the bolt. Firmly tighten the attached red Safety Knob to secure the locking mechanism.
- Reverse steps to fold up.
 - Use the shoulder strap to carry the table with the top against your side.

IMPORTANT!

- Make sure the Safety Locking Cable is in place before use.
- **DO NOT** allow anyone to rest their feet on any of the support structures. They are designed to be lightweight and strong, and are not to be used as foot rests. (Fig. 7)
- Use the Field Feet under the leg extensions to ensure a solid footing on soft or uneven ground. (Fig. 8) These should not be used indoors or on smooth surfaces, as the table may slide.

Cleaning & Care:

- The table is designed to be used indoors or, in fair weather, outdoors. *If* the table does get wet, wipe it dry to prevent rusting.
- For maximum strength, the leg extensions are made of steel which has been finished to prevent rusting. However, if leg extensions are allowed to become dirty, they can stick inside the leg and inhibit height adjustments.
- The aluminum parts require no special care.
- Steel parts or hinges benefit from an occasional drop of oil or a little teflon spray. Wipe off excess.
- Screws, nuts and other hardware should be checked monthly and tightened whenever loose.
