
Balance Poles

Balance poles are useful when a child needs only minimal external support while practicing and developing higher level motor skills such as single leg standing, stepping up and down or backward walking. The poles can also be used to facilitate arm swing during gait. The Balance Poles are 46" tall and have a sturdy rubber tip.

Therapy Bolsters & Stands

The Kaye Bolsters are designed to be used in therapy by infants and children who need to develop balance and posture control. They are available in two sizes, as detailed in the table below.

The versatility of the bolsters increases when they are combined with the CB20 Kaye Bolster Stands. Bolsters then can be angled to add complexity or support without losing the mobility of the bolster. Bolster stands are adjustable in height (5.5" to 11.25" from floor) and are 7" wide and 12.5" long.
