MIRRORLITE GLASSLESS MIRROR CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

To clean your Mirrorlite mirror panels, use a <u>nonabrasive</u> household liquid or foamy window cleaner. "Glass Plus" without ammonia or phosphates is excellent. For light cleaning, such as fingerprints, spray a small amount of cleaner on a <u>soft, clean</u>. <u>lint-free cioth</u>. Plain cotton cloth is suitable. Gently wipe the area to be cleaned. For larger areas, spray the cleaner liberally on the face of the mirror and wipe gently. Any dust or hard particles in the cloth or on the mirror may scratch the mirror. If necessary, dust the mirror lightly before cleaning. <u>Do not press the reflective material</u> <u>against the interior backing</u>. <u>This can result in abrasion and discoloration of the reflective material</u>. Light scratches may be concealed by spraying them with carnuba wax (like Pledge) and polishing gently. Minor dents or wrinkles may result from improper or rough handling. Often these may be removed with a heat gun or hot air blower. <u>DO NOT EXCEED 350*F</u>. Hold the heat source approximately one half inch above the area. Slowly move the blower back and forth. The dent or wrinkle should tighten.
