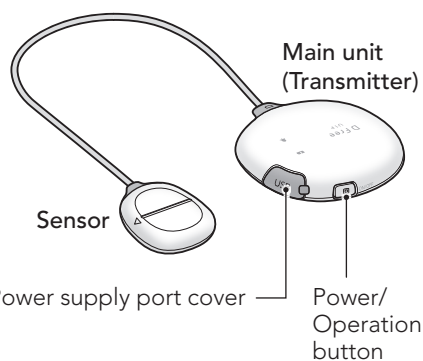
Precautions on handling the device

Take following precautions when using the device. Improper usage may cause device failure.

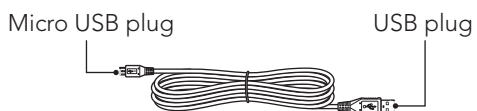
- ⚠ Do not drop or apply strong force.

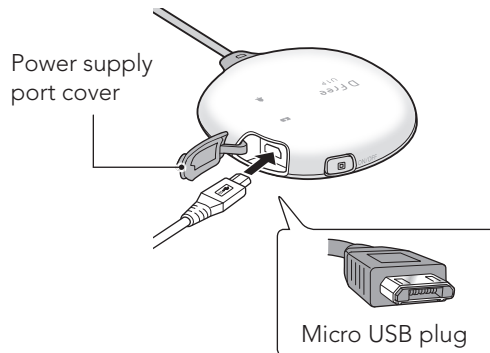


- Charging cable x 1



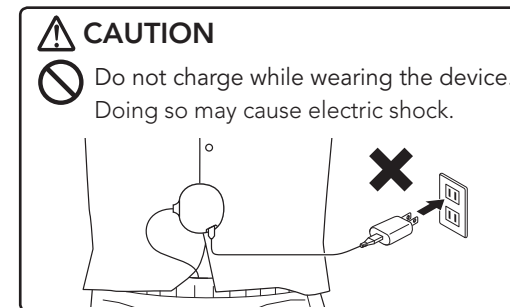
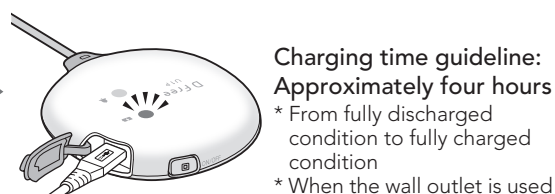
How to Charge

Open the power supply port cover on the main unit and insert the micro USB plug (the smaller plug) of the supplied charging cable into the main unit.

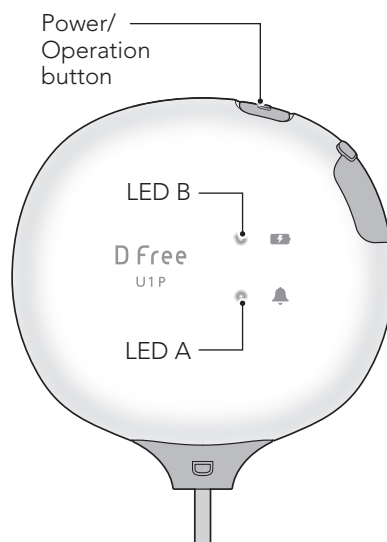


Connect the other side of the charging cable (USB plug) to a PC or connect to a wall outlet using a commercially available power supply adapter.

LED B will turn red while charging. Charging is complete once LED B is turned OFF and LED A turns green.



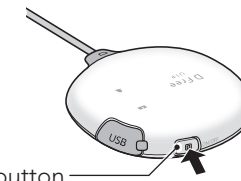
Operation and Notifications



Power ON/OFF

Press and hold the Power/Operation button for three seconds to switch ON/OFF the device.

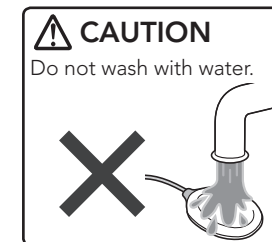
Power/Operation button



How to Clean

Wipe the sensor with a soft cloth dampened with water or neutral detergent.

* Wipe with a cloth dampened with alcohol or hypochlorite disinfectant only when disinfection is necessary.

The app supports iOS devices (iPhone, iPad, iPod) running iOS version 10 or later and Android devices (phones, tablets) running Android 4.4 or later. Note: Senior care facilities and medical institutions need to download the DFree Professional app.
