



ASSEMBLY 20" & 26" INDUSTRIAL HAULER.

- 1. Remove back (6) and front (7) frame assemblies from carton.
- 2. Slide back frame assembly (6) in to front frame assembly (7) fasten securely using bolts (45) and nuts (34).
- 3. Remove, the outside cotter pin (17) and washer (25) from right axle, install wheel with bearing (29) and fix in place with cotter pin and washer.
- 4. Install left wheel (32) on axle, using washer (2), key (59), and nut (24)
- 5. Install the long chain (18) on front sprocket (22).
- 6. Install chain guard (51).
- 7. Install handlebar assembly (4).
- 8. Fasten seat (12) and sissy bar (10) on frame
- 9. Install pedals (27).
- 10. Adjust seat and tighten securely with screws (35) and nut (34).
- 11. Fasten cable to frame with tie cables (46).

Industrial Hauler

This is a recreational unit, not designed for excessive speeds or misuse.

Careless operation may cause ride to lose control and result in serious injury.

Do not brake or turn at high speeds; this may cause to roll-over and rider injury.

Things to know before riding you cycle:

- 1. Know your local bicycle laws and wear a helmet.
- 2. Do not exceed the recommended weight limit 500 lbs.
- 3. Do not stand on unit.
- 4. Wear light-colored clothing.
- 5. Do not ride at night.

MAINTENACE AND INSPECTION

REGULAR MAINTENANCE: Bi-Monthly

- 1. Keep all painted parts cleaned and waxed for along-lasting luster.
- 2. Lubricate the following:
 - Axle shafts
 - Chain- turn pedal crank forward and spray freely.
- 3. When storing over prolonged periods, turn upside down to prevent flats from occurring on the tires. If stored outside, cover to protect finish and moving parts.

PREVENTIVE MAINTENANCE: Every Six Months

These are services that should be performed by you local bicycle shop. A fee may be charged.

- 1. Check tires for wear, rim cuts and valve core alignment (usually caused by improper air pressure)
- 2. Check wheels for cracks and alignment.
- 3. Check brakes for proper operation.
- 4. Check and repack all bearings and adjust all cones.
- 5. Check for worn bearings, cones and cups.
- 6. Check chain for adjustment and clean as needed.
- 7. Check for loose bolts and nuts.

Attention: While your unit is new, some noises may occur when the unit is breaking in. Should they continue for more than 30 days, see local bike shop.

INSPECTION


Check the following, as it applies to your cycle, on a regular basis:

- 1. Hand Brake: Make sure the brake engages, by squeezing the hand brake.
- 2. Wheels: Check wheels for alignment.
- 3. Pedals: Inspect pedals and make sure pedals is tightly attached to crank.
- 4. Handle grips: Replace worn or loose grips.
- 5. Chain: Check for proper tightness. Replace damaged chain immediately.
- 6. Seat: Adjust seat for ride comfort and safety.
- 7. Tires: Keep tires inflated to the recommended tire pressure, as indicated on the tire's sidewall.
- 8. Frame: Replace damaged frame immediately.

Kit Installation Preparation

REAR FRAME

Remove chainguard. Loosen the frame, bearing holder and CB hub bolts. Remove chains. Remove CB hub.

Step 1

Install the 3-sp CB Hub (6) into the open-ended slot. Refer to drawing for the location of hub (6) and correct hub position. Make sure the sprockets line up properly.

Step 2

Install front chain around crank sprocket and outside sprocket on brake hub. Install rear chain on solid sprocket on rear axle. Slide frame assembly apart until chains are tight. Tighten the frame nuts first and then axle nuts. NOTE: When tightening nuts, make sure that frame and hub are straight and not out of alignment. Tighten the nut and screw on the brake arm. Install chainguard.

Step 3

Install grip shifter (13) onto left side of handlebar. Fasten plastic cable stop (2) to hub holder cable guide (4). Run cable from grip shifter down along main frame tube and into plastic stop. Secure cable housing to frame tube with cable ties (1).

Step 4

Refer to drawing and Diagram 1 of Sturmey Archer Installations Instructions for connecting cable to hub and gear adjustment.
